Already during my studies I had the opportunity to work for PAS Jourdan und Müller GmbH in Frankfurt am Main on competitions in Asia and local design projects.

Since 2007 I have been working as an architect in the field of project development and implementation planning in Switzerland. My career began at Husistein und Partner AG in Aarau. This was initially followed by four years at GKS Architekten AG in Lucerne, with the implementation planning of a residential project in Meggen. From 2013, I literally learned how to build at Brüderlin und Merkle Architekten AG in Riehen. We realised medium-sized projects in Riehen and a larger residential project with over 100 flats for the WGN building cooperative as Minergie P / Eco in Basel.

This was followed by a short employment with Butscher Architekten AG in Basel, where I was involved in the implementation planning of the visitor centre for the Novartis company. As a project manager, I spent the years 2021/22 with Vischer Architekten AG in Basel realising two residential building projects.

Since March 2023, I have been responsible as project manager for project development and execution planning of projects at various locations in Switzerland at Varem Development.
